KINDERGARTEN	Kindergarten ***3 Hour Class*** 9am until 12 noon Class Limit: 10	\$150 per month \$50 supply fee	This half-day (3 hour) class taught by a certified teacher, who is also a former homeschool mom, will supplement the child's basic learning at home in the areas of reading, writing, and arithmetic. We will also enjoy music, art, science, snack and play time, as well as socialization.
