LUNCH	12 noon until 1 pm	<b>FREE</b>	<p><i>Lunch is from Noon until 1pm. If it is nice out we will eat outside in the picnic area and then enjoy some outdoor recreation whether its just sitting and talking with friends, playing gaga ball or basketball, or just enjoying the sunshine.
