<b>STUDY HALL</b>	<p><b>Hourly classes</b></p> <p><b>9:00 am until 4:00 pm</b></p>	<p><b>Study hall hours are charged at \$10 per month per study hall hour</b></p>	<p><i><b>Study Hall</b> is meant to be used between two classes that a child has scheduled, or when a student must be on campus early/late because they are waiting for a sibling. It should not be scheduled as a "social hour".</i></p> <p><i>You must sign your child up for Study Hall for them to be able to stay.</i></p> <p><i>***PLEASE NOTE: If you are taking private music lessons, a free half hour of study hall time is included in your lesson time.</i></p>	<p><b>Supplies:</b> Bring schoolwork to do or just socialize with friends by playing board games, doing puzzles or reading books.</p> <p>Students may not use computers, tablets, or phones during study hall.</p>
